

# **Renovating and Upgrading Naval Base Korsør, Denmark – National Competitive Bidding Plus**

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## **Background**

The Danish Defense Estates Agency (DDEA) intends to issue an invitation to submit bids for a combined NATO/national contract under the rules and procedures for National Competitive Bidding Plus (NCB+), as defined by the NATO Security Investment Programme (NSIP).

The Naval Base's facilities need to be renovated and upgraded, and new technical installations must be established. The use of the Naval base is currently limited due to shallow water depths and a limited number of locations where mobile cranes and heavy traffic can operate. Additionally, essential renovation of the base is needed to prevent further limitations in the use of its quay facilities. At the same time, a need has been identified for additional quay length in order to expand overall capacity, particularly in relation to the Danish Armed Forces' task of providing "Host Nation Support".

There will be a cost share between the NATO part (Project 2NB21251) and the national part of the contract.

The contract holds an estimated value of EUR 40,500,000.

The project is carried out according to the project model of early contractor involvement. This means that the contractor is involved during the design phase, and in cooperation with the technical advisor, the project is developed up to the time, where the work is initiated. The contract thus consists of a cooperation agreement that regulates the collaboration between the technical advisor, the contractor and the DDEA during the design phase, and the contractor for the actual constructing works.

With this Notification of Intent (NOI), the DDEA aims to ensure that eligible firms from any NATO member nation are informed of and invited to participate in the upcoming competition.

In accordance with the NATO rules and regulations, vendors from NATO member nations may participate in the competition: Vendors from other nations may not participate in the competition.

### **Time Schedule**

The competition documents will be disclosed on the 5<sup>th</sup> of August 2025 on [ted.europa.eu](https://ted.europa.eu). Firms that wish to participate must provide their bids before the closing date of the 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2025.

Execution of the contract is scheduled for January of 2026 and ends 2028.

### **Terms and Conditions**

Terms and conditions regarding participation in the competition will be a part of the tender material. All documents, including terms and conditions, and time schedule can be found on [ted.europa.eu](https://ted.europa.eu) after disclosure on the 5<sup>th</sup> of August 2025.

The contract will be executed as one overall main contract and the conditions in the Danish General Conditions for Building and Construction Works and Supplies (AB18) will apply.

All documentation will be in Danish.

### **Security**

The documentation will be unclassified.

The Contractor will be required to provide personnel that is or can be authorised to handle information up to and including NATO RESTRICTED. For key personnel on site, a valid NATO Security Clearance up to and including NATO CONFIDENTIAL is required.

Further information regarding security requirements will be presented in the competition documentation.
