SUBJECT: Notification of Intent (NOI) to Request for Proposal (RFP) for Engineering Support for modernization and maintenance of the NEC CCIS application.

REFERENCE: Bi-SC Procurement Directive 060-070 dated 30 June 2015.

1. In accordance with the stipulations of the Bi-SC Procurement Directive 60-70, Annex C, the following information is provided on an Request for Proposal that this Headquarters has the intention to release:

Title of IFIB: Engineering Support for modernization and maintenance of the NEC CCIS application

Requirement: JWC is seeking multiple suppliers to provide various roles supporting:

- 1) The modernization and maintenance of the NEC CCIS application; The main tasks to be supported are within the application server (based on Java Enterprise Edition), and web frontend (mainly based on the ExtJS JavaScript application framework). The front-end is partly in the category of Enterprise Information System, and partly in the Geographical Information System (GIS) category, with the GIS portion expected to require most of the effort through improvements and development of new functionality. The application is recently containerized and undergoing refactoring to better take advantage of cloud deployment, and roles supporting this transformation may also be required.

For general maintenance, full stack development profiles are preferred. In addition, a specialized "functional developer" role will be requested, with a focus on delivering fit-for-purpose end-user functionality through data-design and limited coding in a specialized low-code application framework.

Further, expert roles with specific competencies within the following areas will be requested, possibly for less than the entire

contract period:

- User Experience and/or graphics design.
 - Functional testing to assist with improvements to test management and -automation.
- 2) System Administration, where contractor personnel will play a critical role in operating and evolving a hybrid development and test environment that spans on-premises systems, online software factory platforms, and containerized deployments. Responsibilities will include ensuring reliable server administration, enabling continuous integration and delivery pipelines, supporting Kubernetes and containerized workloads, automating infrastructure provisioning, and maintaining secure, documented, and resilient system operations.
 - 3) Strategic Planning (SFIA Level 5) improving processes and insights to strategy management.
 - 4) Most roles must be available to work on-site at the NEC CCIS System Support Centre in Kolsås, Norway.
