

Notification of intent – Refurbish NEPS – National Competitive bidding +

Background

The Danish Defense Estates Agency (DDEA) intends to issue an invitation to submit bids for a contract under the rules and procedures for National Competitive Bidding Plus (NCB+), as defined by the NATO Security Investment Programme (NSIP).

The refurbishment includes constructions, storage tanks and installations necessary to establish pumping routes for import and export for Understed North and Understed South, including maintaining the possibility of simultaneous import/export of both fuel types (F-75/76 and Jet-A1).

In addition to previous storage capacities at Understed North and Understed South, an additional number of single tanks in Vestbjerg and Vandel must be refurbished.

NEPS from Vestbjerg to Flade, which has been decommissioned since 2010, must be restored with necessary condition checks, refurbishment and cathodic protection.

The contract holds an estimated value of Euro 19.000.000.

With this Notification of Intent, (NOI), the DDEA aims to ensure that eligible firms from any NATO member nation are informed of the upcoming competition.

In accordance with the NATO rules and regulations, firms from the following NATO member nations may participate in the competition:

Time Schedule

The competition documents will be disclosed on December 11^{th} 2025 on ted.europa.eu.

Terms and conditions

Terms and conditions regarding participation in the competition will be a part of the tender material. All documents, including terms and conditions, and time schedule can be found on ted.europa.eu after disclosure.

The contract will be executed as one overall main contract and will rely on the conditions in the Danish General Conditions for Building and Construction Works and Supplies (ABT18).

All documentation will be written in Danish.

Security

The documentation will be unclassified.

It is a prerequisite that the appointed firm can provide personnel that is or can be authorised to handle information up to and including NATO RE-STRICTED. For key personnel on site, a valid NATO Security Clearance up to and including NATO CONFIDENTIAL is required.
