Requirement : The purpose of this NATO Competitive Procurement is to award a contract to provide Cleaning Services for AIRCOM, Ramstein, Germany.
NATO SECRET security clearance for bidder and contractor's personnel is required

Type of contract : Firm, Fixed Price (FFP)
Period of performance : Base Period 01 January 2027 to 31 December 2027 with a further up to four (4) one-year extension options

Bidding procedure : Lowest price technically compliant; the ACO Electronic Bidding Portal will be used for the competition URL: <https://aco.procureware.com>. Eligible firms who are interested to participate in this Competition are invited to apply for registration on the ACO Electronic Bidding portal unless they already hold status of approved/registered vendor.

Funding : Military Budget. Yearly estimated cost 250.000€. Estimated total contract value is 1.250.000 €

Issue Date : Mid-May 2026, planned
Closing Date : Mid-June 2026, planned
Eligibility : Eligibility in accordance with NATO procurement policy.
