### **Purpose**

- 1. In accordance with the provisions of Article XXXII of the NATO Financial Regulations and Financial Rules and Procedures, we are pleased to inform you that the IFB referenced above has been issued by the NATO IS Procurement Service.
- 2. The purpose of this IFB is to award a contract to the selected Bidder per lot for the acquisition and maintenance of three (3) new X-ray machines at the NATO Headquarters in Brussels that meet the needs of NATO as specified in the solicitation of offers.

#### Governing Rules and Eligibility

- 4. This procurement action will follow the International Competitive Bidding procedure specified in Reference A.
- 5. To be eligible to participate in the bidding process, Bidders must:
  - a. Be from one of the NATO Member Nations;
  - b. Be qualified and eligible to receive an award under applicable regulations.

### Bid Procedure and closing date

- 6. Detailed instructions regarding the preparation, submission and evaluation of proposals are provided in Part I of the IFB (Instructions for the Preparation and Submission of proposals).
- 7. Proposals are due by 16<sup>th</sup> April 2024 at 5:30 PM CET.

#### **Evaluation Criteria and Contract Award**

- 8. Bidders will be evaluated on the price offered. Considerations include the legal risks.
- 9. The IFB will be awarded to the responsible Bidder whose conforming proposal represents the lowest price per Lot. The detailed proposal evaluation factors and the phases of the source selection process are described in Part I, Sections 9 to 11, of the IFB.
