1. In accordance with the stipulations of the Bi-SC procurement directive 060-070, Annex C, the following information is provided on an Invitation For International Bid (IFIB) that this Headquarters has the intention to release.

 Requirement : Supply and delivery of Hardware for Fielding, Operations and Maintenance of Targeting Systems at NIFC. This is a re-competition of the SHAPE IFIB ACO-SH-26 that did not result in any contract award since no bids were submitted to SHAPE.
 Type of contract : Firm-fixed price
 Period of performance : One-time
 Bidding procedure : Lowest price technically compliant bid
 Funding : BC (NATO 2030)
 Estimated Value : EUR 300,000.00=
 Issue Date : January 2024 (planned)
 Bid Closing Date : February 2024 (planned)
 Classification of IFIB : NATO UNCLASSIFIED
 Eligibility : Firms (1) that originate and are chartered/incorporated within one of the 31 NATO-member nations, (2) that maintain a professionally active facility (office, factory, laboratory, etc.) within one of the 31 NATO-member nations, (3) that have performed at least three contracts within the last five years substantially similar in scope and magnitude to the requirement described in the solicitation.
